### President's Message

The ACEC/MD fiscal year is quickly coming to an end and I want to take this opportunity to update the general membership on several ACEC/MD and ACEC National events and issues.

#### ACEC Conference in Washington D.C.

- Over 1,000 people attended ACEC's Spring Convention & Legislative Summit in D.C at the end of April. Board action included the passage of a new three-year budget that does not include a dues increase in the first year, consolidating non-regular members under one category, and conforming the bylaws to the current open/appointed committee structure. Regarding the budget, after several amendments were offered on the floor, the Board agreed to make up the lost revenue for the sustainability and energy initiatives by withdrawing funds from the reserve account.
- ACEC/PAC raised over \$125,000 during the conference. For the first time an ACEC/MD representative did not win any prize in the raffle. However, ACEC/MD was recognized for once again achieving its ACEC/PAC fundraising goal in 2009.
- To date, ACEC/MD firm representatives have contributed 54% of Maryland's 2010



ACEC/PAC goal compared to the national average of 25%.

- ACEC/MD will once again hold a local raffle to benefit ACEC/PAC that will be drawn in October. Tickets are only \$100 to be eligible for the \$2,000 grand prize. Member firms are encouraged to sponsor the raffle for \$200.
- Also, to support ACEC's advocacy efforts, an ACEC/PAC national raffle will once again be offered. The grand prize is

\$10,000 and tickets only cost \$200. ACEC/MD member firm purchases go towards ACEC/MD's ACEC/PAC goal, which is approximately \$18,000. 125 of the 500 tickets have already been sold for the drawing that will be held in the fall.

 A contingent of ACEC/MD members participated in visitations to the Maryland Delegation on April 28th to spread the word regarding the transportation and infrastructure crisis and the need for swift action.

#### ACEC/MD Governmental Golf Outing

The ACEC/MD Governmental Golf Outing at Greystone Golf Course took place on May 3rd and over 100 members and guests including Delegate Rick Impallaria; Delegate Charles Jenkins; Delegate Warren Miller; Delegate Susan McComas and individuals from SHA, MdTA, City of Baltimore, Baltimore County, Charles County, Harford County, Howard County, Montgomery County, Prince Georges County, and Washington County enjoyed great weather despite the not-so-encouraging forecast. \$775 was raised for the ACEC/MD scholarship program through Mulligans and the Silent Auction generated \$2,300 for CEPAC. ## ACEC/MD Environmental Business Opportunities Forum

After a decade of success, this year's program focused on a variety of presentations regarding water-related business opportunities in the environmental arena. Over 60 attendees were on hand to hear from representatives of the USEPA Chesapeake Bay Program Office, the US Army Corps of Engineers, Baltimore District Division of Planning, the Maryland State Highway Administration Office of Environmental

Design, the Montgomery County Department of Environmental Protection Division of Watershed Management, the Center for Watershed Protection and the law firm Gordon Feinblatt. Topics included new initiatives to protect and restore the Chesapeake Bay; Maryland's new stormwater management regulations; and rebuilding our cities to meet the Clean Water Act mandates among others. ## ACEC/MD and ACEC/Metropolitan Washington MDOT Modal Presentation

On May 27th, 108 members from 51 firms turned out to listen to the Secretary of Transportation Swaim-Staley and her Administrators and other representatives of the various modes including State Highway Administration, Maryland Aviation Administration, Maryland Transit Administration, Maryland Port Administration, Maryland Transportation Authority and the Motor Vehicle Administration speak about their upcoming programs and potential opportunities for our members. In addition, Matt Rieffer, ACEC's Director of Transportation Programs, was on hand to provide an update on current initiatives in Washington relative to surface transportation, energy/climate change and aviation legislation.

#### ACEC/MD MDOT Matchmaker Program

On June 16th, ACEC/MD sponsored the annual "Matchmaker" program at MDOT Headquarters with the theme being "Designs for Your Future". The program was designed to enhance the ability of MBE/WBE firms to pursue teaming arrangements with prime consulting firms on transportation projects. Approximately 60 MBE/WBE firms and 24 prime firms participated in this very successful event.

#### Transportation Funding Initiatives

Based on feedback from ACEC/MD's visits to Capitol Hill and Annapolis, we need to continue to spread the word about the transportation funding crisis to both our legislators, as well as people "outside of our indus-

try". Our ad-hoc Transportation Funding Committee continues to assist in this regard and members are reminded to use the professionally-narrated video "Transportation and You" that is available at www.acecmd.org. Please encourage your staff to spread the word about the importance of an adequately funded transportation system, and its positive impact on sustainable jobs.

## ACEC/MD Gains Passage of Important Indemnification Bill

#### Transportation Funding Bills Fail to Gain Traction

The focus of the 2010 General Assembly session was squarely on addressing the projected \$2-billion budget deficit. As was to be expected prior to an election year, ACEC/MD's efforts to garner support for a transportation revenue increase fell on deaf ears. ACEC/MD representatives testified in support of bills to both increase the gas tax and to index the tax. We also lent support to legislators that would have provided for a fire wall between the Transportation Trust Fund and the General Fund.

Looking forward, the General Assembly did overwhelmingly approve legislation that will establish a Blue Ribbon Task Force to address Maryland's transportation funding. ACEC/MD representatives testified in support of this legislation and requested an amendment to expedite the date of the Commission's final report. While the approved legislation did not reduce the time frame as much as desired, the final report will be issued by November 1, 2011 instead of the end of 2011. ACEC/MD representatives also made a presentation before the House Appropriations Committee's Transportation Subcommittee on the importance of high speed rail, and the need to ensure that Maryland takes full advantage of available federal funding.

Another major success for ACEC/MD was passage of legislation that prohibits a design professional, inspector, or surveyor from being required to indemnify a promisee against liability for damages caused by the sole negligence of the promise. The new law will be very beneficial for firms doing work on railroad property that currently incur substantial expense and exposure when working for these clients. Thanks to everyone that contacted their elected officials in the eleventh hour to break the log jam in the Senate, which was threatening to allow the bill to die without a vote.

The General Assembly also approved legislation that requires Professional Engineers to demonstrate professional competency. While somewhat controversial, ACEC/MD testified in support of this legislation and successfully argued that the initiation of the law should be delayed for one year. Reportedly, there is also agreement that there will be reciprocity with Pennsylvania and Virginia.

Also at the end of the session, support for a bill to modify the Stormwater Management Act of 2007 resulted in compromise regulations being approved, Under the new regulations developers will be allowed to proceed with projects that have won preliminary local government approval.

Of the nearly 2,800 pieces of legislation that were introduced in the 2010 Maryland General Assembly, your Legislative Committee, chaired by Greenman Pedersen's Jim Blake, reviewed in detail 225 pieces of legislation impacting the profession, including:

## U.S. DOT ISSUES PROPOSED RULEMAKING PERTAINING TO DBES

Congressman Elijah Cummings has advised that the U.S. Department of Transportation (U.S. DOT) has issued a notice of proposed rulemaking pertaining to the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program.

The main issues covered by the rule include the following:

- Personal Net Worth Caps: The proposed rule would adjust the long-standing personal net worth for inflation from \$750,000 to \$1.31 million. The adjustment would apply to the highway, transit, and aviation DBE programs.
- Good Faith Compliance Efforts: The
  proposed rule states that if a recipient of
  federal transportation funds fails to
  meet its overall DBE goal, it should analyze the reasons for the shortfall, plan
  corrective actions, and in some cases
  report to the DOT its findings. Failure
  to present a satisfactory plan would
  provide a basis for DOT action (e.g.,
  denial of approval for contracts or withholding of DOT financial assistance).
- Interstate Certification: To reduce burdens on firms seeking DBE certifi-

- cation in more than one state, the proposed rule indicates that a state would have to accept another state's certification for a firm unless it found good reasons not to do so. In that case, the second state would have to provide an opportunity to the firm for a hearing on the issue.
- Oversight of Prime Contractors: To ensure that prime contractors fulfill DBE requirements, the proposed rule states that recipients of federal funds would be required to certify that they have monitored DBE participation on each awarded contract. To prevent abuse of DBE contractors by prime contractors, a prime contractor could terminate a DBE subcontractor it had used to meet a DBE goal only for good cause, with the concurrence of the recipients.

## DOE ISSUES PROPOSED RULEMAKING FOR SUSTAINABLE DESIGN

The Department of Energy (DOE) recently issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NOPR) for Sustainable Design of Federal Buildings. In addition to establishing revised performance standards for the construction of new and major renovations of federal buildings, the proposed rule will require commissioning activities throughout the process. For a copy of the NOPR and an environmental assessment, please contact the ACEC/MD office.

The NOPR is fairly general, but does require integrated design, including maintaining an integrated project team, which is addressed under the Whole Building Design Guide. It does not specifically address the need for licensed professionals to lead design and commissioning activities, but that may be implicit. The document is also silent on any of the life-cycle persistence strategies, including training of O&M staff, hand-off of materials/manuals to O&M staff, performance monitoring, and plans for either ongoing commissioning or periodic recommissioning.
