All-in-all I believe we had a successful year.

Our Legislative Committee worked diligently for passage of both our bills, which included Providing Fair Competition on A/E Contracts (SB109; HB 283) and Rejecting Retail Sales Tax on Engineering Services (SB235; HB 470), by the Senate and House and signed into law by Governor Hogan. This was a great accomplishment.

Utilizing the Minuteman Fund from ACEC, ACEC/MD entered into an Amicus Brief before the Court of Appeals that confirmed the Economic Loss Rule, where both the Lower Court and Court of Special Appeals had previously ruled in favor. At issue was whether a contractor could sue a design firm for losses when there is no contract between the two entities.

This year 98 member firm employees attended our annual Legislative Luncheon, with 50 people participating in the Annapolis visitations. Let's get more to attend next year!

Approximately 25 ACEC/MD member firm representatives attended the ACEC Annual Convention and Legislative Summit in DC, with 18 individuals participating in the congressional visitations. At issue were Tax Reform and a Long Term National Infrastructure Plan. It was good to hear that all of Maryland's Congressional Delegation expressed support for infrastructure funding.

We reached our National PAC goal for the 12th straight year! Let's get another 12! Thanks to all who have contributed. PAC Sweepstakes tickets are available now. The drawing will be held October 12, 2017 at ACEC/MD's General Membership meeting. This is a good time to support ACEC/PAC!



Our newly formed Utilities Committee held it first program focusing on resiliency, which was a success with over 60 attendees.

Our Career Outreach Committee hosted a successful Maryland STEM Festival event at the Engineers Club for Middle and High School students. This event attracted over 115 students. Thanks to all the engineering firms and their staff who participated and helped organize this event. I cannot wait until next year!

After many years of trying, our County/Municipal Government Liaison Committee was successful in getting Baltimore County to raise the rate cap from \$60 to \$75/hour. In addition, after a multi-year effort, the Baltimore City Liaison Committee was rewarded for their efforts when the Board of Estimates approved increases in both the rate cap and overhead cap. Great job!

A joint Legislative Committee meeting was held with our neighboring member organization ACEC/MW. Remember it is best to show strength in numbers! A Joint program meeting with ACEC/MW was also held with WSSC in December. There was also a good turnout from both ACEC/MD and ACEC/MW for this meeting.

We held three successful Prime/Sub roundtables with interaction between the Owners/Principals and Project Managers. Much was learned from these roundtables including encouraging the primes to include subs when they are organizing tasks.

Another Leadership Program was completed, with 23 participants receiving their certificates at ACEC/MD's Conference held at the Gaylord National Harbor. Congratulations to all! We'll see you at your reunion program next year!

Although we had a great year, we still have much more to accomplish.

While we added six new Regular members and two Affiliate members, we did not reach our goal of a net gain of five Regular members due to the losing three member firms. Our focus next year will be to enhance retention of firms.

Three years into the election cycle, we have raised \$62,000 out of our \$75,000 goal for the state PAC, CEPAC. ACEC/MD encourages all member firms to participate and contribute to both our CEPAC and the National PAC, ACEC/PAC. The use of PAC funds gets us in front of our state and federal elected representatives to discuss business issues of importance to your firm. Money talks!

As previously mentioned, we are looking to focus on retention this coming year and to ensure participation in ACEC/MD throughout the year, including: having at least one person from each of our member firms attend one meeting each year; more participation on our committees; attending our programs; and attending our conference.

SUCCESS REALIZED DURING 2017 SESSION

We are pleased to report that both pieces of legislation initiated by ACEC/MD were



passed in the 2017 General Assembly Session. With strong support from the Senate Education, Health & Environmental Affairs Committee (EHEA) Chair Joan Carter Conway, Senate Bill 109/House Bill 283 - Procurement-Prohibition on Procurement reduces the current lifetime prohibition to two years on an individual and the firm that subsequently hires the individual if the specs or RFP developed by the individual are used on another project. Passage of the legislation was also applauded by government agencies such as DGS, who saw the current law as an

impediment to hiring employees.

Senate Bill 235/House Bill 470 - Sales and Use Tax - Declaration of Legislative Intent Services was initiated as a direct response to the actions of Comptroller Peter Franchot, who was equating professional forensic engineering services with services provided by private detectives, which are subject to sales tax. Obviously, the ramifications could go beyind forensic engineering to other engineering related services such as construction inspection. There was little resistance to the initial hearings in both chambers, but eventually concern about the legislation centered on the fact that engineering services were being singled out, when other professional services are also not subject to sales tax. Eleventh hour efforts by Delegates Keith Haynes (D-44A) and Frank Turner (D-13) pushed the legislation across the finish line with a change highlighting that only detective services are subject to sales tax and that the Comptroller needs to follow the will of the General Assembly.
